The network, active in over 125 countries, provides consultancy for the implementation of sustainability policies for low-emission, nature-based, equitable, resilient and circular development.

The ICLEI platform offers participating cities the opportunity to frame local policies at a not only European but also international level, increasing visibility, partnerships and the exchange of good practices.
