Mayor Adapt The Covenant of Mayors for Climate and Energy

What is it

The Covenant of Mayors for Climate and Energy (Mayor Adapt) is the new Covenant of Mayors initiative to involve cities in promoting the objective of the European Green Deal.

Objectives

The Mayor Adapt (officially launched on October 15, 2015) set the first common challenge to support the implementation of the 40% reduction in greenhouse gases by 2030, committing the cities to approve Local Action Plans for the Climate and Energy.

On April 21, 2021, the Mayor Adapt launched new 2050 goals to address new challenges:

- Accelerate the decarbonisation of territories, helping to keep average global warming below 1.5 ° C;
- Strengthen the adaption strategy at local level, making our territories more resilient;
- Increase energy efficiency to ensure safe, sustainable and accessible energy services for all.
